

Personal Holiness

Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Saints, do you understand this Scripture? Without holiness, no one will see the Lord. The weight of this passage is clear, we will not enter the Kingdom unless we are holy, PERIOD.

If the Bible puts so much emphasis on personal holiness, why is this hardly ever taught in the NE/MG churches?

One of those questions I ask professing Christians what it means to be holy, most cannot answer me. True holiness is a hard concept to fully grasp, but it is an essential part of the Christian life.

Can someone claim to belong to Christ and never pursue holiness? Both the Old and New Testaments put a high priority on holiness; therefore why do most "christians" in the western NE/MG churches fail to even attempt it?

They had best to seek to understand this crucial part of the Christian life, it may cost them their salvation if they continue to fail.

So what is holiness? The holiness of God is so far beyond our comprehension that we struggle to grasp it. If we could grasp a complete image of an infinite God with our finite mind, then we could fully grasp His holiness. Even a small glimpse of God drives men to their knees. Isaiah saw a vision of God and cried, "Woe to me for I am undone!" Job claimed that if he could see God he would ask God why all this trouble has come upon him. When God spoke to Job, he never asked God why, but instead cried out, "I am unworthy and I lay my hand over my mouth". When the prophet Ezekiel saw the same vision Isaiah saw, he fell on his face to the ground until God lifted him up.

Throughout the Bible you see the same response when men encounter God. No man has or can see God in all His glory. Moses begged God to reveal His glory. God said that no man shall see His face and live. Why? What does not measure up to the holiness of God cannot survive in His presence. Sin does not affect God, but the holiness of God will always consume sin. We are sinful by nature. There will be a day when we will be made pure and can see God face to face, but until then we MUST pursue holiness and draw closer to God.

In simple terms (if not simplistic), holiness is to be set apart. God is set apart from everything. He is unique and above His creation. Nothing measures up to God and nothing can even be compared to God. The finite human mind can't grasp God because there is nothing in creation that can be compared to Him. Symbolism is used to paint a picture in the mind's eye. The Bible often points to something that can be seen as a symbol for us to get a small glimpse of the things that can't be accurately explained. For example, Jesus pointed to Gehenna as a symbol of what hell is like. Hell can't be fully grasped, but a valley where dead animals and every kind of vile waste was thrown and burned offered a vivid picture that people could relate to. The symbolism is meant to fall short of the real thing because it serves only to give a glimpse into the mystery that is being explained. However, with God, there is never a symbol given because there is nothing to compare even on the smallest scale. God made it very clear that He did not want to diminish His holiness by any comparison. That is why the second great command says,

"Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth." Exodus 20:4

Once we get a symbolic idea of God, we lose the awesomeness of God. We close our mind to the majesty of God and focus on what we have symbolized.

The holiness of God is the highest honor expressed in the scripture. In scripture, what is repeated is done so to stress importance. Jesus frequently used repetition to alert His followers to a point He did not want them to miss. Jesus frequently said, "Verily, Verily I say to you..." to precede critical truths. Even the apostles would repeat themselves to stress importance. However, when it comes to the holiness of God, the Bible makes it the highest of importance by saying, holy, holy, holy is the Lord... Isaiah saw the angels around the throne saying that God is 'holy, holy, holy' and in Revelation we see it again.

"And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, LORD God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come." Revelation 4:8

There is no other 'triple stressed' point that I can find in scripture. The Bible stresses the holiness of God so we can understand that He is above anything that we can possibly imagine. He is separate above all creation and nothing can compare to God. We are holy by becoming partakers of His holiness. **We are separated from the world to be holy in Him. We should be unique and set apart from the world around us.** We are not holy because of who we are or what we do, but because what God does in us. We inherit the holiness of God.

"Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest." Revelation 15:4

This passage expresses an important truth; **"for thou only art holy"**. We aren't holy and can't be. I was born in the world and everything I have or can do of my own power has come from the world or my own nature. **I can't be separate from the world unless God transforms me into a new creation.** I don't have the power from myself to do anything that does not reflect my own nature which has been polluted by sin. Only God can produce His goodness within me. It is God's Spirit within me that sets me apart from the world that is contrary to His holiness.

Why even bother trying to be holy if we can't do it? This is the LIE that satan has poisoned the Church with through NE/MG teachers, pastors, and the brethren themselves that believe the LIE.

"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?" 2 Peter 3:9-12

I went to an unbiblical Purpose Driven "bible study" with a friend recently, where the format was teaching lies to everyone there on how to be a witness to the world. The "leader" asked how we should "witness" the gospel now that we are in the new covenant church and are not under the law! I stated that God is long suffering in our sin and giving us mercy by not killing us or having His Son return yet. But as I pointed out that God sometimes kills people for their sin even though they claim to know His Son. As I stated the passage from *Acts 5:1-11* where Ananias & Sapphira were deceived and their hearts were filled with satan and they lied to Peter, and God killed them. These were believers; this passage PROVES beyond any doubt that it is a false belief that you cannot be deceived by satan once your hearted is sealed by the holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is only sealing you unto salvation, not your heart, mind, or will. In the Heart Chapter I explain in detail what the heart actually is and what God seals and what satan can get to.

But the point I am trying to make here is that the NE/MG false church and the worldly christians in them are taught that no one can achieve holiness so don't try, and your habitual sin that you practice, well God's OK with that. LIES LIES LIES!

You see, once you wake up from the deceit like I have from both catholicism and the NE/MG church, it will NEVER EVER happen again. It is because of my tenacity to learn His Word and my love for Him for the gift of salvation is evidenced in that I obey Him. Without obedience, all there is is an outward expression of christianity, an empty vase; *If ye love me, keep my commandments John 14:15*. And this whole book in reiterating His Word here, is about obeying Him in comparison to the false church and your false christians who do not obey Him, yet condemn me for trying. Pure gratitude, not some 3rd or 4th holy fire baptism thing, just pure gratitude is why I obey.

Anyway, this passage in itself answers the 'why' question. If this world will one day be dissolved along with everything in it when Jesus will come in all His glory, why put our future inheritance here? Will we invest in a sure loss? Realistically speaking, most people do. The Bible warns us not to be taken by the deceitfulness of lust. The great deception lures us into investing our hope in the world that will be dissolved so that we neglect and even forfeit our future inheritance. All the repentance and sorrow in the world will not correct the loss we will suffer when this life is over.

Look at *Hebrews 12:9-17*

"Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness. Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby. Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed. Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled; Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright. For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears."

If we belong to God, He will chastise us when we stray. The issue then becomes with the NE/MG people, why do they say they are not being chastised by God? They say they have this great relationship with Him, yet they look just like the world, maybe conservative but worldly none the less. The answer is here, they don't belong to God!

Look at your worldly churches and friends, they are in opposition to His commandments, yet no chastise? Like I said, if that is the case they are not of Him.

All the True Christians I know, including myself are always being chastised by God when we stray. This book I compiled is God using me to show you His Word to chastise you, this gives me hope for you. I'll pray for another messenger to come to pull them out of the harlot.

Verse 10 makes it clear that God doesn't chastise us for His profit, but for our good. God sees the end result and longs for us to inherit His promises. It is better to suffer His correction than to miss His inheritance. Through the pursuit of holiness and peace with all people, we can be confident that we are walking in God's grace. You see, I try to have peace with everyone, but true peace is only within the confines of Him. When I point out to false christians that they are not examples of Christ because they have being worshipping another jesus and another gospel, they institute a pattern of bitterness and condemnation, they even condemn the Biblical Truth I give them! So don't misconstrue their wickedness as being righteous and the Truth that I give being wicked.

"Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!" Isaiah 5:20-21

Bitterness and lust will turn our hearts from holiness and then we are at risk to become just like Esau. Esau was the elder brother who rejected his birthright and was willing to sacrifice it to fill his immediate desires. He just could not wait, so he forfeited his future for a morsel that was gone when he got up from the table. **If we don't belong to God, He will not chastise us when we are pursuing the dissolving world. If someone can live without holiness and worldliness, and never feel convicted, they do not belong to God.**

People get mad at me for speaking the Truth and living and acting like a True Christian. Did any of you ever stop to think that what you are hearing from your NEMG "christian" friends and mentors are LIES? Did you not see all of this? The reason is that people become seduced, by a spirit they thought was the Holy Spirit but in fact was a dark spirit imitating the light. That is who and what the body of the NEMG is.

Now that you have thrown away, or burned hopefully, all the false bibles, the Truth should be awakening you.

In the NE/MG church, people do not like to think of God as a judge, but the Bible forewarns us that God will judge, I have a whole chapter on Judging, so I will address that later...

1 Corinthians 3:16-17

"Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are."

The stern warnings of scripture are only harsh to those who choose to disregard them. I love His commandments and His warnings now! When I was unsaved as a false professing NE/MG christian, I hated reading all of God's warnings of His Judgment and His commandments that told me to NOT to do the things of this world I loved and to do the things of the heavenly Kingdom I thought were stupid, or radical, or fanatic, or extreme. Just satan lying to me. Now I live in complete freedom in His obedience as an Ambassador of the King, Lord Jesus the Christ.

God's warning of judgment isn't to make us feel guilty, but to direct us away from harm and toward the promise. There is a difference between guilt and conviction. The Holy Spirit convicts us of sin and leads us toward repentance and a close walk with Him. **Guilt is the result of rejecting the conviction of the Holy Spirit.** We rightly feel guilty when we insist on going down the road that God says will lead to our destruction. When we are deceived into believing the false promises of the lust of the world, we cast aside the promises and warnings of God. Guilt becomes the remembrance of what lies ahead therefore we don't want to be reminded of God's holiness. **Whether we hide from guilt or resist conviction does not change the end result.** The commands of God are life to those who respond to God.

Revelation 20:6

"Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years."

Those who walk with God will be holy because they inherit God's holiness. Judgment has no power over those who can take refuge in God. Only those who lack holiness will be left in the judgment.

How to be holy.

Colossians 1:21-23

"And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight: If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;"

I already told you the fact that God alone is holy. By nature, we were alienated and enemies of God, but through the cross, we have been reconciled so that He can present us as holy and blameless. **This is the foundation we build our understanding upon.** To be holy, I must receive God's own holiness. The holiness I present to God is what He has given to me. Don't lose sight of this principle as I take you to examine how we become holy. **We act in obedience, but it is not my own holiness, but God's holiness given to me.** I want to finish this study by looking at the four principles for obtaining holiness. There are two passages that shed light on living holy.

Romans 12:1-2

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

1 Peter 1:13-17

"Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:"

Be transformed

God transforms us by His power and His Spirit. Apart from God's grace, there is no transformation, there is no forgiveness and there is no way to be holy. Our transformation begins at the cross. We surrender our sins and every part of our lives to Him and He redeems us from the inside out. **I can't cling to my old life and still be submitting to God for redemption, there must first be surrender!**

Saints, look closely at the NE/MG churches and the people there. They haven't surrendered jack! They profess things with their mouths yet they are as worldly as any conservative atheist pursuing every lust of this world... And right now your conditioning of the false bibles is telling you "he can't judge like that, it's wrong!" No, it's righteous; I took the 2x4 out of my eye 13 years ago, and God COMMANDS me to judge righteously.... They're in good company, the NE/MG is predominate in the western culture..

"Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it." Matthew 7:13-14

This is where the NE/MG really goes hog wild into apostasy. They teach that we are all sinners and we have to dwell in our past through psychobabble ministry programs that keep you in bondage in your sin. Like the Celebrate/Life Recovery stuff, they continually rehash and talk about (just as Freud and all the nut cases taught) your sin that you struggle with. If you don't have a habitual sin, then something's wrong with you! Yet God tells us, He will forgive our sin, He tells us to sin no more, He tells us through His power He will destroy sin, He tell us He will send our sin to the bottom of the sea where even He will not remember them, yet the NE/MG churches and their satanic ministries keeps you almost

in a ritual ordinance of the remembrance of your sin. It's like God isn't God enough to destroy sin in you, so you need to turn it over to the worldly shaman's for treatment. LIES LIES LIES!

*"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: **old things are passed away;** behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;" 2 Corinthians 5:17-18*

It is only after the transformation of becoming a new creation in Christ that we can say, "Now all things are of God". Every thing in this life is a part of God's hand and God's plan once we are in Christ. We die to ourselves and God raises us as a new creature.

Tell me folks, where does it say in the Word that old things, like all that sinful garbage that CR says you have if you are a christian and if you say this prayer, but old things won't be passed away right now. You have to keep coming to this worldly Christianized AA program and stay in bondage until satan's minion says you're healed? **No, if all things aren't passed away you didn't become a new creature and thus your profession of faith and repentance to my Lord Jesus Christ was false and He never made you His.**

And if we are truly His people we will ask questions as we disciple that person and see through Scripture they never got saved because their lifestyle is the same. And if we really love them, we will open up the Word for days on end with them until they either kick us out of their house or they drop to their knees in REAL repentance and become a child of God.

Romans 6:7 tells us "*For he that is dead is freed from sin.*" Not free to commit sin, but free from sin. In other words, sin has no power over us, we no longer desire to sin, we desire to obey God and do His will. Sure our sinful nature is in competition with holiness, that's the flesh that wars inside of us against our soul/spirit. God will never force us to be holy, it must be a free choice out of love for God. That is another sign of our salvation, if we have no desire to be holy, but yet we desire to be sinful then we were never saved you can be sure of that! Until I die to myself, I can't live in the holiness of God. When I am seeking His purpose, all things in life will fall into that purpose. **It isn't a one-time act, but a life long process of dying to self daily and living for Him.** This is why we must OBEY Him when it comes to judging ALL THINGS and separating from the world and from the false christians, unless of course we see them to witness the Truth to them!

Present yourselves to God

The passage above, *Romans 12:1-2*, tells us to present our bodies to God as a living sacrifice. Until I make myself available, I am not usable. When I hold on to my own life, God can't give me a holy life in Him. Jesus said that he who saves his life will lose it, but he who loses his life for My sake will find it. My life in my hands means little to God. What can I do that God can't do for Himself? When I present my life and my body to God and declare myself as being set apart for Him, I yield my rights to pursue my own desires and I pursue God instead. Then God is able to take my life and use me to make an eternal impact by His power, not my NE/MG version of psychobabble christian programs. God makes me holy when I present myself as a holy vessel that no longer belongs to me, but to Him.

The question that begs to be answered, is why do people who claim to be Christians, refuse to reject the world and refuse to OBEY God? Then answer becomes obvious if you really can be honest with yourself. People, whom you may think are brethren, really aren't. Like I said somewhere else in this "book" if not once: You are either a missionary or a mission field. I ask confrontational questions to find out which you are so I may adjust how I talk to you. Jesus and the Apostles did the same thing, some better than others. I am not God or a prophet, so I don't know what people really are until I ask PROBING questions to find out. I use the parameters that Jesus and the Apostles taught us to use. The NE/MG teaches that doing that is judgmental, unloving, arrogant, rude, and whatever else they can

throw at us for them feeling better about their disobedience and our obedience. If you keep believing in their LIES then it may cost you more than you know.

Another FALSE teaching is that one can hear the audible voice of God in our day and time. That is a LIE perpetrated by satan via the name it and claim it crowd of the false western culture Pentecostal signs and wonders movement. Read your Bibles! In particular, Ephesians 2:20, God SPEAKS to us through His Word, anyone tells you he hears God speak to him in an audible voice is either a LIAR or is hearing a voice from a demon, another spirit. We go into more detail in the Heresy Chapter. Because of this ever growing LIE, people believe their emotions, demonic spirits, and experiences as being Truth. And even when confronted with the Word of God that contradicts their false beliefs, they cling to the “voices” instead of the Written Truth.

Renew your mind

“And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.” Romans 12:2

This is a daily process. I can't live on yesterday's holiness. My goal is to be holier today than I was yesterday. Forward progression. Israel was taught this example by the manna in the desert. As they wandered 40 years, they ate manna from heaven. God commanded that they could not gather enough for more than one day. The ones who did saw it rot in the jar. God used manna from heaven to illustrate the truth yet to be revealed.

But today it has been revealed.

" He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it." Revelation 2:17

Jesus promised that those who overcome, He would provide them with the hidden manna. That manna is the bread of life – the Word of God. Only those who pursue the holiness of God will gain the deep understanding from the Word of God. You can't get filled up on the Word of God and, at the same time, neglect your daily renewal, and God will not fill someone who is filled with the world. This why when people argue with me on biblical issues that sounds almost word for word from the NE/MG mantra I know you are deceived. You can keep reading those false bibles and think you can continue on with your "spirit" directing you to a private interpretation of your false bibles, or you can come out of the harlot, read ONLY His Pure Word, His Holy Spirit indwelt Word, and the Holy Spirit will tell you His interpretation of the Pure Word, not yours. Then when you become obedient, He will begin to reveal things that will astound you.

That is why the NE/MG church, want to call me fanatic or extreme. They have never tried to conform to His Word, just their own golden calf they call Jesus. Had they obeyed they would have had the desire to become holy and then God would of revealed more of His Truth to them, it's just a matter of obedience.

Many live life this way. They have a great 'mountain top' experience and expect it to last them a lifetime as they go back to the world. God calls for a daily renewal through prayer and His word. The purpose of this renewal is so we can draw closer to Him. Holiness is a byproduct of a close walk with God. You can't have a close walk with God without holiness and you can't have holiness without a close walk with God. One always leads to the other. When we get our spirit filled with the holiness of God, we forget that the purpose is not so we can feel good for a moment, but so that we can use what God has given us to be drawn into a deeper walk with Him.

If you are relying on yesterday's holiness, it is rotting in the jar. If you are relying on yesterday's prayer and study, it will fail you. God calls us to personal holiness that is founded on a daily relationship with Him. His word is the revelation of Himself to us. I can't know God apart from His word.

Rest your hope in Heaven

The above passage in 1 Peter 1 also instructs us to fashion our conduct based on our hope in His revelation. When we put our focus on this world, then we become conformed to this world.

We need to look ahead toward the grace that is being stored up for us. If our hope is in this life, we will be disappointed. I do believe that God wants to bless us, but that is not my hope. I don't know when or how God will bless me, so if my hope is in the blessing, I will be disappointed when God doesn't fulfill my expectations.

My hope though, is in the fact that anything I lack in this life is grace stored up for me in the life to come. It is better to lack here because God will right every wrong and fulfill every shortfall if my faith endures until the end. If my hope is in the world – even if I am using the promises of God as my foundation, I will not be satisfied. God's promises are not for us to bind God, but for God to teach us to trust Him, and if we say we trust Him, then the EVIDENCE of that trust is in the obedience that we perform.

When my hope is in heaven and in the coming revelation of Jesus Christ, I will be drawn into the holiness of God. My focus is on Him and reaching the finish line. Those who hope in the world will hope in His delay and neglect their call to holiness.

The holiness of God is His character that is set apart from the world. Our holiness is our lives being set apart for Him. We become holy by conforming to the image of Christ and becoming like Him. We adopt His character and inherit His holiness. This can only happen through obedience. It is the commands of God that guide us to the character of God and conform us to His will. His will is where our future lies and we can only inherit God by becoming like Him.

More Bible verse commanding Holiness

Matthew 5:48

Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

John 5:14

Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.

John 8:11

She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

John 15:4

Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

Romans 8

Read the Whole Chapter

Romans 12:1-3

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

2Corinthians 7:1

Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Galatians 5:16-26

This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

Ephesians 1:4

According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. But ye have not so learned Christ; If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

Ephesians 5:27

That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Philippians 3:15

Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, God shall reveal even this unto you.
